Launched **July 31, 2025** as part of **Developer Home**: devhome.corp.adobe.com

Parliament Transitioning: All new onboarding's will happen through IDocs and Parliament's domain will redirect to IDocs during the week of **August 18, 2025**.

All existing Parliament documentation will be fully migrated - **no manual steps needed, current documentation bookmarks will continue to function without interruption and any updates to your repo will reflect in IDocs.**

What is IDocs? Adobe.ly/docs — a brand-new, centralized, Adobe-wide system for all of your internal engineering documentation. It's part of **Developer Home** and integrates directly with your code workflow.

With IDocs, you can:

- Write docs in Markdown, OpenAPI, PlantUML, and more
- Keep docs up to date via Git pull requests
- Auto-publish to a central, searchable platform
- Once connected to IDocs, documents in a Git repo are automatically published to the IDocs system whenever updates are merged to the main (or designated) branch.
- Auto-publish to a central, searchable platform

IDocs is the new standard for publishing internal developer documentation across Adobe and will replace Parliament.
